In the coming months we will be having many fund-raisers and events. If you'd like to help, donate or become a member, or wish to receive more information please contact us at:



\$125.00 per hound by Harbor Cities.

PLEASE NOTE: An update to the titer clinic is that I have spoken with Dr. Holland at Protatek regarding the use of Antibiotics prior to testing and she does not feel it will effect the results of the tests, she feels that any titer would show through. With regards to Steroids such as Prednazone she said that it can be tricky and given at an immunosuppressive dose (high) that it may cause a false negative titer result.

Even if one of your hounds is not on my list and you want them to be tested you can simply just show up to the titer clinic with them....we wanted the list for a general idea for a quote.
